Homework Help Program

The 2019 Homework Help Program will begin on **21st February 2019** and operate **every THURSDAY from 3:30pm–4:15pm** in S31 which is in the Beacon area of the school. (top floor of the S building)

The Homework Help Program provides a quiet space for students to complete independent homework and assignment tasks or review work for tests and exams. Students are encouraged to do some personal reading if they have completed their homework. There is a teacher on duty in the room who is available to assist students with homework tasks, should they request a need for assistance.

It is expected that all students will respect the study environment of other students participating and it is expected that they will attend for the full 45 minutes. Homework Help is not a compulsory program but is available each week as a support for any student who would like extra homework assistance.

Students must register by completing a permission form and returning it to the Beacon.
