The Premier has announced a number of changes in relation to lockdown regulations for Victorians for the next six weeks.

In terms of St Bede's College, please note the following:

- 1) All students will be Remote Learning from Wednesday 5 August until the end of Term 3.
- 2) Tuesday 4 August is a student free day (No Classes onsite or online)
- 3) Sons of essential workers will be supervised onsite at the College and will follow the remote learning program. Please contact Mr Jones mi@stbedes.catholic.edu.au if this supervision is required.
- 4) Students should have all learning materials at home with them.
