

MEET OUR PARTNER MENTONE TIGERS

Meet our partners!

Our long standing friends, the St Bede's / Mentone Tigers Amateur Football Club. Formed in 1993 from an amalgamation of three clubs, the senior team won their first season in the VAFA D Section, capping off a memorable year.



The three clubs included

- 1.Mentone Football Club, which was originally formed in 1904 and as such the club celebrated its centenary during 2004. The club competed successfully in the Federal Football League and then the Southern Football League prior to 1993.
- 2.St Bede's Old Collegian Football Club, which was formed in 1963, competed initially in the YCW League before joining the VAFA in 1972 and playing continually in the Amateurs through to 1993.
- 3. Mentone Junior Football Club also amalgamated, being the third club to join the 'St Bede's / Mentone Tiger's Amateur Football Club'.

In 2020, the club enhanced its facilities with a principal purpose of the St Bede's/Mentone Tigers AFC continuing to field teams in every age group from Under 8's and Auskick through to senior VAFA football. This enables players to progress through age groups in an amateur football environment. In any given season, the Club fields around 20 teams (boys and girls) teams in the SMJFL and between 7 and 8 senior teams in the VAFA. (3 x Under 19, 2 x Women's open age & 3 x Men's open age). With the advancement of women's football, the club has committed to fielding more teams in each age group in future years, so every week during the winter season, the club provides sporting opportunities for around 700 participants and their families to enjoy.

The much needed redevelopment at Mentone Reserve provides new unisex change facilities, a modern social area and office space for the small army of volunteers required to community clubs.


We are 20 days away from the Class of 2003's reunion! We are pleased to announced that special guest, Brother Ken joining us for the evening.








ARCHIVES 1982

The story based on the dramatized fictionalized story of the Salem witch trails was performed by 22 cast members in the College hall.




ARCHIVES 1992
